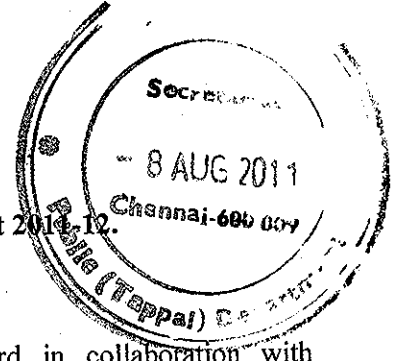
Sir,

5. Please ensure that the entries are submitted within prescribed time limits, failing which organizer will not be responsible for accommodation and transport.
6. List of players along with photocopy of their identity card should be authenticated by the authorized officer under his signature & seal.
7. All the participants shall carry individual Identity Card/Identity Slip for verification of eligibility criteria by the Organizing Committee/Representatives of the Board at the venue of the All India Civil Services Tournament.




8. Addresses, Telephone numbers, E-mail Addresses may be indicated by the participating State/UTs/RSB's.
9. Managers meeting are likely to be held on the evening of a day before the date of commencement of the tournament.
10. Every participating team may bring two flags representing their States/UT/Regional Sports Board with them.
11. It should be ensured that every member of the team reports at the venue and participate in the tournament as scheduled. Failure to do so shall be treated as an act of indiscipline. All the participating team shall maintain strict discipline on and off the venue of the tournament. Any act of indiscipline /misbehavior/misconduct will attract the provisions of CCS (conduct) Rules since Government Employees are treated 'ON DUTY' during All India Civil Services Tournament.
12. The information about rules and regulation, entry form, change in dates/venues/cancellation etc. about the AICS tournament is available on our website i.e www.persmin.nic.in. All the participating teams are, therefore requested to check from our website/organizers of the tournament about any possible change before starting their journey.
13. Referee's decision shall be final and binding on the competing teams.
