Sub: New Pension Scheme – Implementation of New Pension Scheme for Officers of AIS belonging to Tamil Nadu Cadre appointed on or after 1.1.2004 – Orders – Issued – Regarding.

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In continuation of the Government letter third cited I am directed to state that it has been brought to the notice of the Government that who should bear the matching contribution for the arrear subscription as well as future subscription of the officers served / serving in the Boards / Corporations etc under Tier I and how they could contribute to the Scheme. It is no doubt that the matching contribution should be borne by the Employer concerned ie. where the officer drawing salary and deducting his / her subscription towards Tier I. The head of account has also been indicated in Para 2 (f) of the GO second cited for crediting the matching contribution from the respective entities like Central Government / Boards / Corporations etc., with which the officers are working.

2. As far as the matching contribution for the arrear subscription from 1.1.2004 to 31.12.2011, I am directed to state that once the pending contribution of the officers are arrived at, the Employer concerned {Central Government / Boards / Corporations etc.,} has to be addressed to remit the entire matching contribution for the arrear subscription of the officer in one lump-sum to the Government account in the following head of account under intimation to the Government as well as to the officer concerned:


“0071 Contributions and Recoveries towards Pension and Other Retirement Benefits – 01 Civil – 800 Other Receipts – AE Matching Contribution of arrear subscription received from Public Sector and other Undertakings {DPC 0071 01 800 AE 0000}”

3. The Employer concerned may also be requested to remit the entire matching contribution for the arrear subscription of the officer concerned to the Government account within a month from the date of intimation. Once the Employer concerned remitted the entire matching contribution for the said arrear subscription of the officer concerned to the Government account, the Government shall credit the said matching contribution equivalent to the arrear subscription of the officer in the relevant head of account.

4. I am therefore to request that necessary arrangements may be made to address the Employer concerned duly indicating the matching contribution for the arrear subscription of the officer concerned with a request to remit it to the Government account in the aforesaid head of account within a month from the date of intimation.
