ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above as amended from time to time orders were issued prescribing the terms and conditions of deputation of IAS officers to various State Public Sector Undertaking/Boards/Joint Sector Companies and Private Companies under relevant rules of the IAS (Cadre) Rules. At present, the terms and conditions of deputation of IAS officers to State Public Sector Undertakings/Boards etc. are issued by concerned administrative departments of Secretariat after routing the files to the Public (Special.A) Department in pursuance of the transfer and posting orders issued by this department. In the monthly meeting of Secretaries held on 30-9-91 it was decided to discontinue the practice of issuing independent orders regarding terms and conditions of deputation in respect of officers and to make reference of the general orders issued by the Finance (BPE) Department in the posting orders itself. The matter was examined in detail and it has been decided to discontinue the practice of issuing independent orders regarding terms and conditions of deputation in respect of IAS officers on foreign service by the administrative departments of Secretariat. It has also been decided to indicate in the orders of posting that the IAS officers posted on foreign service shall be governed by the general terms and conditions prescribed in the G.O. first read above and that the period of deputation shall be for three years from the date of relief from the old post/assumption of charge as the case may be or until further orders whichever is earlier.

2. The Government accordingly direct that the practice of issuing independent orders regarding general terms and conditions of deputation in respect of IAS officers on foreign service by the departments of Secretariat be discontinued hitherto. Reference regarding terms and conditions of deputation in respect of IAS officers on foreign service shall be made in the posting orders issued by this department.

3. As regards IAS officers who are already on deputation on foreign service orders regarding terms and conditions of deputation/extension of period of deputation shall continue to be issued by the administrative departments of Secretariat.
