Sub: All India Services - Medical Reimbursement to the officers and their family - Wholly Dependent under Rule 2(C) of All India Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1954 - Instructions - Regarding.

Ref: Circular No.706/2012-1, Public (Special.B) Department, dated: 18.04.2012.

I am directed to invite your attention to the reference cited, wherein instructions have been issued to all the All India Service Officers working in this State Cadre to utilize the New Health Insurance Scheme for the medical cases covered under this scheme and to utilize All India Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1954 for other ailments / medical reimbursements not covered under the Insurance Scheme.

2. As per Rule 2(C) of All India Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1954, family means:-

- (i) Husband or wife as the case may be, of the member of the Service; and
- (ii) The parents, sisters, widowed sisters, widowed daughters, minor brothers, children and step-children wholly dependent upon the member of the Service and are normally residing with such member including dependent brothers, dependent divorces/separated daughters and step-mother.

The members of the family shall be regarded as "**wholly dependent**" **upon the member of the Service if they ordinarily reside with the said member and their total monthly income does not exceed Rs.3,500/- plus dearness allowance thereon as on the date of consideration.**

3. In view of the above, the members of All India Services are requested to adhere to the explanation to Rule 2(C) of All India Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1954, while claiming the medical bills relating to their parents.
