I am directed to invite your attention to the references cited and to state that the Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Personnel and Training, in the Office Memorandum 7th cited have stated that there is no requirement for filing of declarations of assets and liabilities by public servants now and the Government is in the process of finalising a fresh set of rules and the rules will be notified in due course to prescribe the form, manner and timelines for filing of declaration of assets and liabilities by the Public servants under the revised provision of the said Act. I am therefore request you to file the declarations as may be prescribed in the fresh set of rules to be published by the Government of India.
