ORDER:

The State of Kerala has witnessed the heavy rainfall during the month of August 2018, which caused devastation to the infrastructure in several Districts of the State besides loss of many lives. The Government of India have declared the devastating floods in Kerala as a "Calamity of severe nature". There is an urgent need for joining the rebuilding efforts.

2. The Tamil Nadu IAS Officers Association and the Tamil Nadu Secretariat Officers' Association Chennai in the letters first and second read above have expressed their willingness to contribute One day's salary from their members towards relief and rehabilitation measures in the State of Kerala.

3. The Government has decided to accept the request of the Tamil Nadu IAS Officers Association and the Tamil Nadu Secretariat Officers' Association Chennai and direct that the voluntary contributions of One day's salary shall be deducted from the salary bill of the Officers for the month of August 2018 towards relief and rehabilitation measures in the State of Kerala.

4. Accordingly, the Drawing and Disbursing Officers shall be instructed to make use of the provisions in the Web Pay role application in the calculation of one day salary in the August 2018 pay bill. The amount shall be deducted on the basis of the gross amount of salary for the month of August 2018. The said amount deducted from the salary shall be credited directly to the Chief Minister's Distress Relief Fund Savings Bank account maintained at State Bank of India, City Branch Thiruvananthapuram {SB A/c No. 67319948232 IFSC Code: SBIN0070028 Swift Code: SBININBBT08 PAN. AAAGD0584M} on the due date of disbursement of salary. The officers already remitted the amount are free from do it again. The officers who have already presented their pay bills for the month of August 2018 without making deduction to the Kerala flood relief, may send their contributions directly through Net Banking or other sources as required by the Government of Kerala and intimate the fact to the Government as well to the Commissionerate of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai.

The DDOs shall inform the Government and the Commissionerate of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai on the ECS mode of deduction from the monthly pay bill and the amount credited to the CMDRF account of the State of Kerala along with the list of Officers of IAS (TN Cadre) from whom the contributions are deducted.

6. The amount deducted from the officers serving in PSUs / Corporations / Autonomous bodies on their own mode of payment of salary, shall also be credited directly to the CMDRF account of the State of Kerala by ECS mode and arrange to send the list of officers who have made contributions to the Government as well as to the Commissionerate of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai.

7. The Principal Secretary / Commissioner, Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai is requested to intimate the Government about the exact amount transacted towards contribution of One days' salary of the members of the Service Associations to the CMDRF account of the State of Kerala for its relief and rehabilitation measures.
