ORDER:

Among the Coastal Districts of Tamil Nadu, Pudukkottai, Thanjavur, Tiruvarur and Nagapattinam Districts were met with Severe Cyclonic Storm “GAJA” which caused massive damages to the houses and huts, electric poles, hundreds of hectares of coconut, cashew, mango, plantain, teak, and casuarina plantations / trees were uprooted. High winds with speed of 100 to 160 kmph during cyclones take an immeasurable misery and devastation to the infrastructure in all categorized people (ordinary dwellers, farmers, fishermen etc.,) in the above districts.

2. The Relief and Rehabilitation works in the storm affected Districts are being carried out on war footing. In order to join the rebuilding efforts of the State, the President, Tamil Nadu IAS Officers' Association, Chennai has expressed their willingness to contribute one day's salary from the members towards relief and rehabilitation measures in the storm affected Coastal Districts of Tamil Nadu.

3. The Government has decided to accept the request of the Tamil Nadu IAS Officers' Association, Chennai and direct that the voluntary contributions of One day's salary shall be deducted from the salary bill of the Officers for the month of November/December, 2018 towards relief and rehabilitation measures in the storm affected Coastal Districts of Tamil Nadu.

4. Accordingly, the Drawing and Disbursing Officers shall be instructed to make use of the provisions in the Web Pay role application in the calculation of one day salary in the November, / December 2018 pay bill. The amount shall be deducted on the basis of the gross amount of salary for the month of November/December, 2018. The amount of voluntary contribution to be recovered from the salary of IAS Officers of Tamil Nadu Cadre through the audit officers concerned would be credited directly to the Chief Minister's Public Relief Fund, Savings Bank account by Electronic Clearing System (ECS) to the designated saving Bank Account of CMPRF to Indian Overseas Bank, Secretariat Branch, Chennai 600 009 {SB A/c No.117201000000070 IFS Code IOBA0001172, CMPRF PAN: AAAGC0038F} on the due date of salary.

5. The DDOs shall inform the Government and the Commissionerate of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai on the ECS mode of deduction from the monthly pay bill and the amount credited to the CMPRF account of the State along with the list of Officers of IAS (TN Cadre) from whom the contributions are deducted.

6. The amount deducted from the Officers serving in PSUs / Corporations / Autonomous bodies on their own mode of payment of salary, shall also be credited directly to the CMPRF account of the State by ECS mode, under intimation to the Government.
