ORDER:

The Government of India in the letter read above has stated that the general guidelines under the Performance Appraisal Report stipulate that annual health check-up is mandatory for all IAS officers above the age of 40 and may be totally dispensed with for officers below the age of 40, except in the case of a medical incident. The Government of India have finalized the modalities for the health check-up in respect of IAS officers on Central deputation and requested the State Governments to work out appropriate arrangements and authorize Government as well as the Private Hospitals in the State for the health check-up of IAS officers working with the State Government.

2. The Director of Medical Education, Chennai has furnished the list of leading hospitals in Chennai & in Districts along with the details of charges fixed by those hospitals for the tests prescribed in the mandatory Annual Health Check-up. In order to facilitate the IAS Officers in this regard, the Government after careful examination have decided to permit the IAS Officers serving in connection with the affairs of this State to get the mandatory Annual Health check-up as prescribed in Form IV under Rule 3 of the All India Services (Performance Appraisal Report) Rules, 2007 in any hospital of their choice at a cost of **Rs.5,000/-** or the actual cost charged by the hospital authorities **whichever is less** and they are also authorized to get reimbursed the above amount by submitting the original bills.

3. Accordingly, the Government permit the IAS Officers serving in connection with the affairs of this State to get the mandatory Annual Health check-up as prescribed in Form IV under Rule 3 of the All India Services (Performance Appraisal Report) Rules, 2007, in any hospital of their choice at a cost of Rs.5,000/- or the actual cost charged by the hospital authorities whichever is less and they are also authorized to get reimbursed the above amount by submitting the original bills.

4. The expenditure is debitable to the head of account to which the above Officer Pay and Allowances originally drawn during the said period of treatment.

5. The Audit authorities concerned are requested to admit the claim without insisting on an essentiality certificate.
